Thank you for choosing to run a World Cup sweepstake in aid of The Tom Bowdidge Youth Cancer Foundation. Whether you are organising this at work, school, home, local club or with friends - every entry will make a huge difference to the lives of teenagers and young adults facing cancer.

This fundraising pack contains everything you need:

- Step-by-step instructions for running your sweepstake.
- Suggested rules.
- 48 team draw slips and Entry Trackers ready for you to print and cut out.
- Details on how to pay your money into The Tom Bowdidge Youth Cancer Foundation.

The 2026 FIFA World Cup kicks off in June 2026 across the USA, Canada, and Mexico - 48 nations competing, and all it takes is one lucky draw to win your sweepstakes.

How to run your sweepstake

Step 1 - Decide your entry fee

Choose an entry fee that feels right for your group. Common amounts are £2, £5, or £10 per entry. The more people who enter, the bigger the pot - and the bigger the donation to the Foundation.

Step 3 - Collect your entries

Each person who enters pays their entry fee and draws a team at random. Record who has drawn which team on the tracker sheet. One entry = one team. People can enter multiple times if they like.

Step 5 - Watch the World Cup!

Sit back, enjoy the football and keep an eye on the results. You'll need to track progress through the group stages, then the knockouts, right through to the final.

Step 7 - Pay in your donation to the charity

The remaining money after prizes is your donation to The Tom Bowdidge Youth Cancer Foundation. See the next section on "How to pay in" at the end of this pack. Please aim to pay within 4 weeks of the final.

Step 2 - Print and cut out the team slips

Head to the "Team Draw Slips" page of this pack and print it out. Cut up the slips so each team is on its own piece of paper, fold them up, and pop them in a hat, box or bag.

Step 4 - Share it!

The more people who know about it, the more you'll raise. Share in your team WhatsApp group, newsletter, email or noticeboard.

Step 6 - Award the prizes

Once the Final is played and a World Cup winner is crowned, check your entries and pay out the winner/s. See the suggested prize split below.

Suggested prize split

We suggest keeping most of the pot as a donation, with a smaller prize for the winner. Here are some options depending on your pot size:

Option	Winners get	Charity gets
Simple (winner takes all)	25% of pot	75% of pot
Top two	Winner 20% of pot Runner up 10%	70% of pot
Top three	Winner: 15% 2nd: 10% 3rd: 5%	70% of pot

Important legal note

However, if you plan to sell tickets to members of the public or charge for entry via a public facing promotion, you may need to register as a small society lottery.
